Marked T 22 S R 9 W S 7 B T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.54*30'W., 171 lks. dist.

Marked T 22 S R 9 W S 6 B T.

Land, mountainous, 22.60 chs.

Soil, first and second rate.

Timber, Fir, Alder and Maple.

Undergrowth, dense, vine-Maple, Hazel, Thimble and Salal-berry, Fir, Arrow wood, Fern and Rhododendron. 80.00chs.

Commenced at the corner to secs. 5 and 8,

Thence, I run, West between secs. 5 and 8,

Va. 20*E.

0.25 Began to descend and pass over cove.

31.75 Top of ridge sloping West.

39.00 Canyon, Course SW.

40.00 Set Alder post, 5 feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground on hillside sloping South for $\frac{1}{4}$ S corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the N. face, from which

A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.52*E., 62 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S.1*W., 23 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Pass over spur.

45.00 Wells creek, 25 lks. wide, Course S.

45.75 Wagon road, Course N. and S.

46.50 Ascend hill.

74.85 Intersected N. and S. line, 361 lks. N.3'E., corner to secs. 6 and 7.

Set Fir post, 5 feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in ground for closing corner to secs. 5 and 8, marked C C T 22 S R 9 W on the E., S 5 on the N., and S 8 on the S. faces with 5 grooves on the S. and E.
