## Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 9 W.

Intersected West Bdy. of T., 235 lks. North of the corner to secs. 1 and 12, which is a sand stone 5 x 8 x 8 inches above ground marked with 5 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the N. sides with a X on top of stone, from which,

An Alder, 12 ins. diam., bears N.17\*E., 18 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 6 B. T.

An Alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S.68\*E., 75 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 7 B. T.

A Cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears S.3\*W., 6 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 10 W., S. 12 B. T.

An Alder, 16 ins. diam., bears N.12\*W., 60 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 10 W., S. 1 B. T.

I obliterated marks on bearing trees in secs. 6 and 7.

I set sand stone 18 x 16 x 8 ins., 12 ins. in ground on hillside sloping E. at the point of intersection for closing corner to secs. 6 and 7, marked C. C. on the E. with 5 notches on the S, and 1 notch on the N. faces, from which,

A Fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.48\*E., 118 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 6 B. T.

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.50\*E., 43 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 7 B. T.

A Hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S.68\*W., 56 lks. dist.

Marked C. C. T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 6-7 B. T.

Land, mountainous. 90.68 chs.

Soil, first and second rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Alder, and Maple.

Undergrowth, dense Fir, Alder, Salalberry, vine-Maple, and Hazel, Thimbleberry and Salmonberry. 90.68 chs.
