CHAINS

80.77 Intersected East Bdy. 420 lks. North of the corner to secs. 30 and 31, which is a post, 2 feet above ground 2 ins. square, marked T. 22 S. S. 30 on the NE., R. 8 W., S. 31 on the SE., R. 9 W., S. 36 on the SW, and S 25. on the NW., faces, from which,

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.74*E., 131 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 8 W., S. 30 B. T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.84*W., 137 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 36 B. T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.67*W., 66 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 25 B, T.

Agreeing in part with notes furnished by the U. S. Surveyor General.

The bearing tree, in sec. 30 having been killed by fire, I marked,

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.8*E., 92 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 8 W., S. 30 B. T.

I obliterated marks on the bearing trees in sec. 25 and 36.

Set Hemlock post, 4½ feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground at the point of intersection for the closing corner to secs. 25 and 36, marked C. C. on the W., T. 22 S., S. 25 on the N., and R. 9 W., S. 36 on the S. faces, with 1 groove on the S., and 5 grooves on the N. sides, from which,

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.86*E., 68 lks. dist.

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.25*W., 62 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 36 B. T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.67*W., 66 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 25 B. T.
