CHAINS

Undergrowth, dense vine-Maple, Thimble and Salmonberry
and Rhododendron. 80.77 chs.

Thence, I run,

S.0°01'E., on true line, between secs. 35 and 36.

Va. 20°E.

14.15 A creek, 10 lks. wide, Course East.

22.50 A creek, 5 lks. wide, Course NE.

31.20 A creek, 2 lks. wide, Course West.

40.00 Set Hemlock post, 5 feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in
the ground on hillside sloping West for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner
marked $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. on the W. face, from which,

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.85°E., 27 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. B. T.

A Hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears N.44°W., 43 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. B. T.

55.25 Top of ridge, Course E. and W. + 100

Descend gradually.

63.25 A Fir, 24 ins. diam., a line tree, marked with 2 notches
on the N. and S. side.

73.40 Intersected S. Bdy. of T. 11.16 chs. East of corner to
secs. 1 and 2 T. 23 S., which I re-established, as
follows:

Set Fir post, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in
the ground on hillside sloping S. for corner to secs.
1 and 2, T. 23 S., marked T. 23 S. 1 on the SE., R.
9 W., S. 2 on the SW. with 1 notch on the E., and 5
notches on the West edges, from which,

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.45°E., 10 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S36 B. T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.40°E., 7 lks. dist.

Marked T. 23 S., R. 9 W., S. 1 B. T.
