Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 27 B. T.

A Maple (stump), 7 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 35 lks. dist., Marks obliterated.

The other bearing trees had been destroyed.

A Cedar, 50 ins. diam., bears S.4*E., 116 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 35 B. T.

An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.37*W., 108 lks. dist.

Obliterated the sec. mark^{ON}/B. T. in 26 and 27, from the NE. corner of sec. 34, I run, S.89*51'E., between secs. 27 and 35.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.62*W., 91 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 35 B. T.

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.66*W., 21 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 27 B. T.
