82.15	<p>The SW. corner to secs. 26 and angle in secs. 35. Land, mountainous. 82.15 chs. Soil, second rate. Timber, heavy, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Maple and Alder. 82.15. Undergrowth, dense, Rhododendron, Hazel, vine-Maple, Salmonberry and Salalberry. 82.15 chs. October 26, 1894.</p>
	<p>Commenced at the corner to secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, which I established by running South 80.00 chs., from the corner to secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22. I set sand stone, 20 x 14 x 6 ins., 16 ins. in ground on steep hillside sloping East for corner to secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked with 2 notches on the S., and 3 notches on the E. sides, from which, A dead Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.22*E., 8 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 22 B. T. A Dogwood, 6 ins. diam., bears S.61*E., 107 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 27 B. T. A dead Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.74*W., 80 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 28 B. T. A dead Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 61 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 21 B. T. Thence, I run, S.0*02'E., between secs. 27 and 28. Va. 19*30'E.</p>
