CHAINS

Land, mountainous. 74.28 chs.
 Soil, second rate.
 Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Maple and Alder.
 Undergrowth, dense of Salalberry, vine-Maple, Rhododendron,
 Arrow wood, Huckle and Thimbleberry. 74.28 chs.

Commenced at the corner to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30,
 which is a post, 30 ins. above ground, 4 ins. square,
 firmly set, marked T. 22 S., S. 20 on the NE., R. 9 W.,
 S. 29 on the SE., S. 30 on the SW., and S. 19 on the
 NW. faces with 2 notches on the S. and 5 notches on
 the E. edge, from which,

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.75°E., 24 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 20 B. T.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.11°W., 55 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 30 B. T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.47°W., 14 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 19 B. T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.23°E., 100 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 29 B. T.
