

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

I then run, thence, North 1.61 chs. to a point 192 lks. West of the meander corner between secs. 15 and 16, making the whole distance 28.75 + 7.86 + 1.61 chs. or

38.22 To the point 192 lks. East of the meander corner on right bank of river.

Thence, I continued North from the meander corner. Through grain field.

46.80 Fence, Course E. and W., and road to Scott'sburg.

66.25 A creek, 2 lks. wide, Course S.20*W.

84.00 A creek, 2 lks. wide, Course S.15*W.

85.45 After diligent search, I was unable to find any evidence of the corner to secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

I set a sand stone 20 x 16 x 6 ins., 15 ins. in ground in land slide on hillside sloping South for the corner to secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, marked with 4 notches on the S., and 3 notches on the E. sides, from which,

A Cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N.81*E., 39 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 10 B. T.

A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.51*E., 145 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 15 B. T.

A Maple, 20 ins. diam., bears S.44*30'W., 22 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 16 B. T.

A Maple, 4 ins. diam., bears N.13*W., 40 lks. dist.
Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 9 B. T.

Land, mountainous, South of river.
Soil, first rate.
Timber, Fir, Cedar, Maple, Alder and Oak.
Undergrowth, vine-Maple, Hazel and Fir.

Note: the whole length of this line is 85.45 chs., the true course from the corner to secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22 to the meander corner on the right bank of river is N.2*52'W.
