49.40	Top of ridge, Course NW. and SE. Descend.
81.00	A creek, 6 lks. wide, Course N.10*W.
82.65	The corner to secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28. Land, mountainous. 82.65 chs. Soil, third rate. Undergrowth, Salal and Thimble, Fir, Hemlock, Alder, Willow and Arrow wood. <p style="text-align: right;">October 27, 1894.</p>
Commenced at the corner to secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. Thence, I run, South, between secs. 16 and 17. <p style="text-align: right;">Va. 20*E.</p>	
5.60	A creek, 5 lks. wide, Course W.
8.50	A creek, 2 lks. wide, Course W.
27.00	Road to Scottsburg, Course NW. and SE.
27.65	Fence, Course NW. and SE. and enter grain field.
40.00	Could not find $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner in grain field.
45.35	Right bank of the Umpqua river. Could not find the meander corner. I send flag across river, and set it on line, between secs. 16 and 17. I then run West 130 lks. to a point, from which, the flag bears S.9*28'E., which gives for distance across river to flag, Nat. Cot. x base or $5.9971957 \times$ $130 = 7.80$ chs., making the whole distance $45.35 +$ 780 or
53.15	To left bank of river. After diligent search, I could not find the meander corner. Continued South from flag. Ascend.
62.25	Top of spur sloping NE.
