	Descend.
66.70	A creek, 1 lk. wide, Course N.70*E. Pass over spur.
88.20	To a point 455 lks. West of the corner to secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, which I re-established, as follows: Set Alder post, 4½ feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground on hillside sloping North, marked T. 22 S., S. 16 on the NE., R. 9 W., S.21 on the SE. S. 20 on the SW. and S. 17 on the NW. faces, with 2 notches in the S. and 4 notches on the E. edges, from which, A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.45*W., 34 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 20 B. T. A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 55 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 17 B. T. I marked, A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 37 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 16 B. T. An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.17*E., 33 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 21 B. T. Land, mountainous south of river. Soil, first and second rate. Timber, Fir, Alder, Oak and Maple, Undergrowth, vine-Maple, Hazel, Oak, Fir and Hemlock. Note: the whole length of this line is 88.20 chs., and the true corner is S.2*57'E. <p style="text-align: right;">October 29, 1894.</p>
	Commenced at the corner to secs. 31 and 32. Thence, I run, N.89*52'E., along the North Bdy. of sec. 32. <p style="text-align: right;">Va. 19*30'E.</p>
