CHAINS

The meanders of Mill Creek.

Beginning at the mouth of the creek in sec. 15, I run
up the west or left bank of same.

<u>Course</u>	<u>Chains</u>	In Sec. 15.
S.16 $\frac{1}{4}$ *E.	6.50	Garden
S.8*E.	2.00	Steep hillside.
S.37*E.	1.20	Steep hillside.
S.32*E.	12.00	Set M. P. from which C. Hackers House, West about 3 chs. A myrtle, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 3 lks. No other trees. Land, 2nd rate. But little timber. Underbrush, salmon & thimbleberry.

In Sec. 22.

S.32*E.	1.50	To old mill site.
S.25*E.	3.00	Valley on right.
South	4.00	Field, course N. & S.
S.20*W.	3.00	Field, course N. & S.
S.45*W.	2.00	
N.87*W.	6.50	Hill closes to creek.
S.45*W.	5.00	Set temp. post. No witness trees.

There is a narrow valley along this creek of 1st rate
land. Tide runs up creek about one mile farther ac-
cording to report.

Timber, inferior fir.

Underbrush, same as other described.
