27.00	Spur, course N. descend steep.
40.00	A sandstone bluff on W. slope 10 ft. high, 50 ft. wide, which I mark with cross (x) at exact cor. point with $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. from which An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears N.86*E. 50 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S.86*E. 60 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
41.00	Dry creek, 10 lks., course N.
49.00	A point of rock on spur, course NE.
66.50	Stream, 2 lks. course N. Along N. slope.
71.00	Canyon, course NE.
80.25	Spur, course S.
88.50	Canyon, course SE. Along S. slope.
104.10	Intersect W. bdy. 8.12 chs. N. of cor. to secs. 24, 25, 19 & 30 set by W. R. Whipple, which I find a mark (cross (x) on bedrock, with 2 notches on S. & 4 notches on N. from which A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.43*E. 13 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 19 B T. A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.37*E. 21 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 30 B T. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.33*W. 13 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 25 B T. A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.11*W. 33 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 24 B T.
