53.60	A stone in place 20x12x8 ins. above ground which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. side, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.80*W. 44 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.10*E. 80 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	
54.60	Stream, 2 lks., course SW.	-200
63.60	Stream, 2 lks., course W. Ascend.	
73.00	Spur, course W. Along W. slope.	+300
78.00	Divide, course S.80*W. Along E. slope.	
93.60	The cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 & 12. Land, mountainous, 93.60 chs. Timber, young fir, alder. A little good fir. Undergrowth, same with thimbleberry, Dense. Aug. 15, 1894.

Where it turns northward, I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, from which A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.87*E. 5 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.82*W. 10 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

46.00	Spur, course N.10*W. Descend E. slope.
