CHAINS	<p>A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.75°E. 50 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p> <p>A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.85°W. 20 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>
58.67	Spur, course S.65°W.
67.20	Intersect meander cor. bet. secs. 15 & 16. Land, mountainous, 67.20 chs. Timber, none of value, a few scattering fir. Underbrush, thimbleberry, tar balm, vine maple, hazel & sallal. Dense most of the way, 67.20. Aug. 25, 1894.
	<p>From the meander cor. on the N. or right bank of the river bet. secs. 16 & 17.</p> <p>I run N.0°3'W. on a random line bet. secs. 16 & 17. Var. 20°30'E.</p>
12.80	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. & at
51.19	The cor. to secs. 8 & 9 bears E. At this point I set a sandstone 20x16x12 ins., 16 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 16 & 17 marked C. C. with 4 notches on E. & S. edges, from which A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.10°E. 152 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W C C S 16 & 17 B T. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.37°E. 57 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 16 B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.1°W. 150 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W C C S 16 & 17 B T.
	Erected a mound of stone, 2 ft. high, 4 ft. base around this cor.
9.00	Thence I run E. along N. slope and at chs. intersect at the cor. to secs. 8 & 9. Var. 20°30'E. Land, mountainous, 9 chs.
