From the meander cor. on the S. or left bank of the river bet. secs. 15 & 16.

C. for meander cor. bet. secs. 16 & 21, from which An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S.76*W. 100 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 21 M C B T. An alder, 16 ins. diam., bears N.76*E. 118 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 16 M C B T. Land, mountainous, 10.50 chs. Soil, rocks. No timber, dense underbrush, willow, alder & tassel wood. July 7, 1894.
