CHAINS

Dense undergrowth of willow & thimbleberry.

July 9, 1894.

Across river, offset to north bank, base S.51°E. 16 chs. Angle opposite 71°45'. Distance across

Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for meander cor. bet. secs. 16 & 17, marked T 22 S R 10 W M C on S., S 17 on W., S 16 on E. faces, from which

An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N.48°W. 172 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 10 W S 17 M C B T.

An alder, 17 ins. diam., bears S.44°30'E. 233 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 10 W S 16 M C B T.

From the meander cor. on the S. or left bank of the river, bet. secs. 16 & 17, I run with the meander in sec. 17. Var. 20°30'E.
