

Meanders of T. 22 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

N.27*W. 160 lks. dist.
marked T 22 S R 10 W S 8
M C B T.

Land, mountainous, 42.03 chs.

Soil, first 20 chs. rocky. Last
22 chs. rocky, 4th rate. Between
51.50 soil sandy & rich, a narrow
bottom along river.

Dense underbrush & timber all the
way except 4 chs. at mouth of
creek.

89.03 chs. (total distance 93.03
chs.)

In the last part of this line there
seems to be an error of 9 chs. in
departure west in the notes fur-
nished me.

July 17, 1894.

Offset to east bank and run a base S.22*E. 8.70 chs.

Angle opposite 23*. Distance across 15.74 chs.

15.74 A willow, 4 ins. diam., which I marked for meander cor.
bet. secs. 8 & 17, marked T 22 S R 10 W M C on W., S
8 on N., S 17 on S. faces, from which

A willow, 7 ins. diam., bears N.15*E. 25 lks. dist.
marked T 22 S R 10 W S 8 B T M C.

A willow, 6 ins. diam., bears S.30*E. 27 lks. dist.
marked T 22 S R 10 W S 17 M C B T.

From the meander cor. bet. secs. 8 & 17 on the W. or
left bank of the river, I run with the meanders in
sec. 8.

Var. 20*30'E.
