

CHAINS

Surveyed by Albert Gould, Deputy Surveyor under
contract no. 762, dated July 12, 1905

Intersect north boundary of township 17 lks East of the
¼ sec. cor. on south bdy of sec. 31, T22S R10W which is
a post 4 ins. sq., 12 inches high, marked and witnessed
as described by the surveyor general..

(Closing Corner for T23S Rgs. 10 & 11 W.)

At intersection, I set a sandstone 24"x14"x12" ins. in
a mound of stone for closing corner of T23S Rgs. 10 &
11 W. I marked CC on S face with 6 grooves on S E & W edges
from which:

an alder 12 inches in diam. bears S.24°E., 47 lks
dist., marked T. 23 S. Rg. 10 W S 6 BT.

an alder 12 inches in diam. bears S.40°W., 48 lks
dist., marked T. 23 S. Rg. 11 W S 1BT.
