

Retracement of the North Boundary of T. 23 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

Undergrowth, small fir, alder, hazel, salmon berry,
thimble berry and sallal.

Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense
undergrowth, 75.48 chs.

At the C. C. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 23 S., R. 10 W.

Thence I run

East, on a blank line along the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

4.66 Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on S. bdy. of sec. 33, T. 22
S., R. 10 W. heretofore described.

9.00 Summit of divide bet. Coos and Umpqua Valleys, 200 ft.
high, bears NW. and SW.

27.00 Bed of dry gulch; course NE.

34.00 Bed of dry gulch, 200 ft. below summit of divide; course
NW.

Ascend.

35.80 Intersect and destroy all evidence of a $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. set
under Contract No. 292.

38.00 Summit of ridge, 200 ft. above point of ascent, bears NW.
and SE.

43.38 Intersect the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 22 S., R. 10 W.,
which is a sandstone, 20x6x6 ins. above ground, firmly
set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor
General.

45.52 Intersect a fir, 14 ins. diam., originally marked for the
cor. of secs. 33 and 34.

All markings upon this corner have been obliterated.

47.00 Bed of gulch, 200 ft. below ridge; course NW. Ascend
200 ft.

54.00 Cross ridge, bears N. and S. and descend.

74.93 Intersect a hemlock tree, 12 ins. diam., originally
marked for the cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T 23 S., R. 10 W.
All marks are obliterated.
