47.35	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.
50.00	Enter old dead timber.
56.37	Intersect line 10.47 chs. N. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. established on old T. line on E. bdy. of sec. 13, T. 22 S., R. 12 W. Cor. and witness trees agreeing with notes furnished. Marked a dead fir, 16 ins. diam., at the point of inter- section for the cor. to secs. 7 & 18 on W. bdy. from which A fir (dead), 30 ins. diam., bears N.80°E. 60 lks. A fir (dead), 36 ins. diam., bears S.20°E. 40 lks.
