49.00	A dead fir, 60 ins. diam. marked with 2 notches on N. & S. sides. on top of a little spur, course N. about 100 ft. above gulch.
	Descend.
55.25	Top of spur, course N. about 175 ft. above gulch.
59.40	Top of a little spur, course N.
63.00	Gulch, course N. about 150 ft. below last spur. Ascend.
75.00	Top of mountain, course NE. and SW. about 400 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
75.57	A fir, 30 ins. diam. marked with 2 notches on E. & W. sides.
80.00	Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground for cor. to secs. 2 and 3, marked T 23 S R 11 W on S., S 2 on E. and S 3 on W. sides, with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges, from which A dead fir, 70 ins. diam., bears S.71*E. 44 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 11 W S 2 B T. An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears S.65*W. 17 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 11 W S 3 B T. An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N.11*W. 23 lks. dist. marked T 23 S R 11 W S 2 & 3 B T. Land, mountainous, 80 chs. Soil, 3rd and 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, alder, maple and cedar. Dense undergrowth, alder, vine maple, thimbleberry and salla.
	Thence I run East, on a true line on N. bdy. of sec. 2. Var. 19*30'E.
	Along S. slope through alder timber.
3.90	Stream 1 lk. wide, course S. Ascend.
