CHAINS

Heavily timbered with young growth fir & alder.
 Dense undergrowth of same and sallal, 49.37 chs.
 June 8, 1894.

East Boundary

I begin at the meander cor. to fractional secs. 1 & 6
 on the S. bank of the Umpqua River bet. Tps. 22 S.,
 Rs. 10 & 11 W. which is a post, 4 ins. sq. marked
 M C on N., R 10 W S 6 on E., T 22 S on S. and R 11 W
 S 1 on W. faces, from which
 An ash stump, 10 ins. diam., bears S.45 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W. 104 lks.
 dist. marked B. T. Remaining marks cut away.
 A willow stub, 7 ins. diam., bears N.35*E. 11 lks.
 dist. marks obliterated.
 A spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears S.8*E. 169 lks. dist.
 which I mark T 22 S R 10 W M C S 6 B T.
 A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears S.14 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W. 134 lks. dist.
 which I mark T 22 S R 11 W S 1 M C B T.
 Dennis Wagoner's house bears N.85*W. about 6.50 chs. dist.
 Thence I run
 South, bet. secs. 1 & 6.
