An alder, 4 ins. diam., bears S.58\*W. 4 lks. dist.  
marked T 22 S R 11 W S 13 B T.

An alder, 4 ins. diam., bears N.39\*W. 19 lks. dist.  
marked T 22 S R 11 W S 12 B T.

Land, mountainous, 85.66 chs.

Soil, 3rd & 4th rates.

Heavily timbered with alder, fir and cedar.

Dense undergrowth of alder, sallal & thimbleberry.

Dec. 15, 1894.

South bet. secs. 13 & 18.

Var. 20\*05'E.

- .41 A burnt fir, 70 ins. diam. which I mark with 2 notches on  
N. & S. sides.
- 10.20 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course W. and ascend.
- 20.50 Top of a spur on W. slope about 450 ft. above last stream  
& descend.
- 21.13 A burnt fir, 36 ins. diam. marked with 2 notches on N. &  
S. sides.
- 25.50 Stream, 1 lk. wide, course W. & ascend.
- 40.00 Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on W. face, from  
which
- An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears East 12 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears N.18\*W. 18 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 44.45 A burnt fir, 36 ins. diam. marked with 2 notches on N. &  
S. sides, on top of mountain, course N.60\*E. about 400  
ft. above last stream.
- Descend.
- Var.. 20\*20'E.
- 51.20 Bottom of a little gulch, course E.
- 58.45 Top of spur on E. slope.
- Descend.
