	Soil, 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and maple. Dense undergrowth, alder, huckleberry and thimbleberry.
	Thence South on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 30. Var. 20*10'E. Ascend.
6.36	A fir, 24 ins. diam. marked with 2 notches on N. & S. sides.
7.20	Top of a ridge, course N.60*E. about 200 ft. above cor. Descend.
12.50	Bottom of gulch, course N.60*E. Ascend.
14.50	Top of a spur, course N.60*E. about 125 ft. above gulch Descend.
22.50	A stream, 1 lk. wide, course N.60*E. about 100 ft. below spur. Ascend.
26.31	A fir, 10 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on N. & S. sides.
29.00	Top of a ridge, course N.62*E. about 275 ft. above stream
33.75	A gulch, course N.60*E. about 100 ft. below last spur. Ascend.
36.75	Top of spur, course N.60*E. about 175 ft. above gulch Var. 20*05'E.
40.00	Set a stone 16x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears W. 32 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A burnt fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.30*E. 20 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
49.75	A gulch, course E. about 100 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
52.75	A gulch, course N.20*E. Ascend abruptly.
53.83	A fir, 16 ins. diam. with 2 notches on N. & S. sides.
