Over marsh through timber.

1.00 Ascend abruptly.

1.90 Bluff, 20 ft. high, course E. & W.

2.70 Bluff, 30 ft. high, course E. & W.

13.10 Top of ridge, course E. & W. 500 ft. high and descend.

15.04 Set a stone 18x12x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which
A cherry, 3 ins. diam., bears S.64*E. 18 lks. dist.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

No other tree in limits.

Mark a cross (x) and $\frac{1}{4}$ B O on a stone N.54*W. 10 lks. dist.

26.10 Stream, 1 lk. wide, course NE. about 200 ft. below top of last ridge and ascend abruptly.

38.25 Top of a ridge, course NE. about 250 ft. above last stream.

Thence over broken E. slope.

46.80 Intersect E. & W. line 1.17 chs. W. of cor. to secs. 11 & 12 at which point I mark a cross (x) at exact cor. point for closing cor. to secs. 1 & 2 with C C and 5 notches on S. & 1 notch on E.

From cor. point

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.86*W. 93 lks. dist.
marked T 22 S R 11 W S 2 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.81 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E. 65 lks. dist.
marked T 22 S R 11 W C C S 1 & 2 B T.

No other trees in limits.

A cross cut on a perpendicular rock marked S1 B O bears N.67*45'E. 10 lks. dist.

Land, 46.80 chs. mountainous, rough and broken; soil 4th rate, rocky. N. 1 ch. marsh.

Heavily timbered with fir, alder & hemlock, 46.80 chs.

Very dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, salmonberry & sallal, 46.80 chs.
