	Thence I run S.0°1'E. on a true line bet. secs. 13 & 14. Var. 20°05'E. Ascend.
10.50	Summit of mountain, course E. & W. about 350 ft. above cor. Course of mountain soon bends SE. Descend.
19.75	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course W. about 250 ft. below the top of mountain. Ascend.
24.50	Top of a spur, sloping NW. about 250 ft. above stream. Descend. Var. 20°E.
31.00	Bottom of a gulch, course N.60°W. about 125 ft. below top of spur. Ascend.
33.34	A fir, 20 ins. diam.
36.60	Top of a ridge, sloping W. about 300 ft. above gulch. Thence along W. slope.
40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, from which An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S.32°W. 25 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. An alder, 7 ins. diam., bears N.11°E. 26 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
42.00	Top of mountain, course E. & W. Descend.
52.25	Bottom of a little ravine, course SE.
67.30	Stream, 3 lks. wide, course SW. Thence along W. slope.
80.00	Set a stone, 14x8x6 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24 with 3 notches on S. & 1 notch on E. edges, from which
