

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 11 W.

CHAINS

A burnt fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.45°E. 125 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 13 B T.

A willow, 4 ins. diam., bears S.56°E. 43 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 24 B T.

An alder, 4 ins. diam., bears S.9°W. 68 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 23 B T.

A maple, 3 ins. diam., bears N.56°W. 36 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 14 B T.

Land, 80 chs., mountainous.

Heavily timbered with young growth of alder & fir.

Dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, sallow, greesewood & mountain balm, 80 chs.

July 21, 1894.

Thence East on a random line bet. secs. 13 & 24.

Var. 20°10'E.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor.

80.26 Intersect East bdy. of Tp. at a point 12 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 13, 18, 19, 24.

Thence S.89°55'W. on a true line bet. secs. 13 & 24.

Var. 20°20'E.

Ascend over N. slope.

70 Top of a spur, course N.

Descend.

9.90 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course NE. about 300 ft. below top of spur.

Ascend.

27.00 Summit of mountain, course N. & S. about 500 ft. above stream.

Descend.

34.75 Bottom of a gulch, course SW. about 400 ft. below top of mountain.

40.13 Set a post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S. on N. face, from which
