	Thence East on a random line bet. secs. 14 & 23. Var. 20*05'E.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.84	Intersect N. & S. line 36 lks. N. of cor. to sec. 13, 14, 23 & 24. Thence N. 89*45'W. on a true line bet. secs. 14 & 23. Var. 20*10'E.
	Descend.
4.85	A dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course S. about 200 ft. below cor. Ascend.
16.00	Top of a ridge, sloping S. about 400 ft. above dry creek. Descend.
29.60	A dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course S. about 400 ft. below last ridge. Thence over S. slope. Var. 20*E.
39.92	Set a stone 20x12x8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which A cedar stub, 24 ins. diam., bears N.10*W. 90 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir stub, 24 ins. diam., bears S.68*W. 190 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
60.00	A dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course S. about 150 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
63.00	Enter creek bottom, course N.70*W. and S.70*E.
66.00	A trail, course NW. & SE.
67.00	Dean's Creek, 25 lks. wide, course NW.
71.25	Dean's Creek, 25 lks. wide, course SW.
75.40	Dean's Creek, 25 lks. wide, course NW.
77.00	Leave creek bottom, course N.70*W. & S.70*E. Ascend, along N. slope.
79.84	The cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23. Land, 66.34 chs. mountainous; soil 4th rate, rocky.
