CHAINS	
	Very dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, salmonberry, sallal & briars, 80.29 chs.
	Thence I run S.0*2'E. bet. secs. 8 & 9.  Var. 20*E.  Ascend.
9.00	Top of a ridge, course NE. & SW. about 300 ft. above sec. cor.  Thence along E. slope.
38.00	Top of same ridge, course NW. & SE.  Descend along W. slope.
40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, from which  A cherry, 4 ins. diam., bears N.73*E. 6 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.  A cherry, 5 ins. diam., bears S.74*W. 15 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
54.00	Top of a ridge, course E. & W.  Descend.
69.20	A stream, 1 lk. wide, course SW. about 500 ft. below top of ridge.  Ascend.
72.98	A point 3.78 chs. W. of cor. to sec. 16 & 17 at which point I set a post 4 ft. long and 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for SW. cor. to sec. 9, marked T 22 S S 9 on NE., R 11 W on SE., and S 8 on SW. faces with 4 notches on S. and E. edges, from which  A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.89*E. 19 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 9 B T.  An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.62*W. 41 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 8 B T.  Land, 72.98 chs. mountainous.
