CHAINS 54.50	Top of a spur on W. slope about 300 ft. above last stream. Descend.
75.00	A stream, 10 lks. wide, course W. about 600 ft. below last ridge. Ascend.
80.00	Set a post, 4 ft. long and 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for cor. to secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21 marked T 22 S S 16 on NE., R 11 W S 21 on SE., S 20 on the SW. and S 17 on NW. faces with 3 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. edges, from which A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.19°E. 70 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 16 B T. A maple, 10 ins. diam., bears S.22°E. 64 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 21 B T. A chittem, 4 ins. diam., bears S.23°W. 108 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 20 B T. A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.8°W. 117 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 17 B T. Land, 80.00 chs. mountainous. Soil, 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, alder & cedar. Dense undergrowth of alder, thimbleberry, cherry, sallal, huckleberry and briars, 80.00 chs.
	Thence East, on a random line bet. secs. 16 & 21. Var. 19°55'E.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.
79.20	Intersect N. & S. line 20 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22. Thence S.89°51'W. on a true line bet. secs. 16 & 21. Var. 20°E.
13.70	Ascend. Top of a ridge, course NE. & SW. about 250 ft. above last stream.
