81.24	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 & 8. Land, 80.24 chs. mountainous. Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, alder and maple. Very dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, salmonberry, sallal, brake and briars, 80.24 chs.</p>
	<p>West, on a true line bet. secs. 6 & 7. Var. 20*E.</p>
	<p>Over S. slope through timber.</p>
3.50	<p>Descend abruptly.</p>
11.00	<p>A dry creek bed, 8 lks. wide, course S.20*E. about 250 ft. below sec. cor.</p>
13.00	<p>A dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course S.70*E. and ascend abruptly.</p>
28.40	<p>Top of a ridge, course SE. about 350 ft. high. Descend.</p>
38.90	<p>A dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course SW. about 350 ft. below top of ridge.</p>
40.00	<p>Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which A myrtle, 24 ins. diam., bears N.62*W. 27 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 7 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>
42.42	<p>Oar's house bears S.47*W.</p>
49.10	<p>A fir, 24 ins. diam. on line marked with 2 notches on E. & W. sides.</p>
50.70	<p>Wagon road, course N. & S. Enter bottom.</p>
51.26	<p>A fence, course N. & S. 20*E. Thence in meadow.</p>
54.50	<p>Oar's house, bears S.31*E.</p>
