

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 11 W.

CHAINS	
34.00	Stream, 2 lks. wide, course N. about 200 ft. below top of last ridge. And ascend.
37.90	Top of a ridge, course N. about 250 ft. high. And descend.
40.00	A stone in place, 12x7x4 ins. above ground which I mark $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.80*W. 50 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T. A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.87*E. 110 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
42.00	Bottom of a gulch, course N.
51.00	Top of a ridge, course N. about 400 ft. above last gulch. And descend.
59.40	Stream, 3 lks. wide, course N. about 400 ft. below top of last ridge. And ascend.
65.30	Top of a spur, course N. with a hunter's trail on top. A point about 300 ft. above last stream. And descend.
78.80	A dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course N.20*W. about 350 ft. below top of last spur. Ascend.
85.64	Intersect N. & S. line 12.76 chs. S. of cor. to sec. 16 & 17 at which point I set a stone 18x16x12 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 8 & 17, marked C C with 4 notches on S. & E. edges, from which A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 17*W. 41 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 17 B T. A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.26*W. 41 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 8 B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.35*E. 66 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W C C S 8 & 17 B T.
