40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face from which A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.86*W. 141 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A myrtle, 5 ins. diam., bears N.39*E. 57 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
49.25	Bottom of a little gulch, course S.
51.60	Enter clearing course NE. & SW. Millers house bears S. 69*E. about 6.50 chs. dist.
60.00	Leave clearing, course NE. & SW. Ascend.
77.00	Top of a ridge, course N. & S. about 500 ft. above last dry creek. Descend.
83.00	Bottom of a gulch, course N. about 300 ft. below top of last ridge. Ascend.
86.75	Top of a ridge, course N.
86.95	Intersect N. & S. line 5.50 chs. S. of cor. to sec. 16, 17, 20 & 21 at which point I set a stone 14x12x7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 17 & 20 marked C. C. with 3 notches on the S. and 4 notches on E. edges, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.2*W. 215 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 20 B T. A cherry, 20 ins. diam., bears N.42*W. 118 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 17 B T. A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.86*E. 65 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W C C S 17 & 20 B T. Land, 86.95 chs. mountainous. Soil, 3rd & 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, alder, cherry, cedar and myrtle.
