marked T 22 S R 11 W S 30 B T.

A crabapple, 7 ins. diam., bears N.85*W. 18 lks. dist.

marked T 22 S R 11 W S 19 B T.

Land, 80.00 chs. mountainous.

Soil, 3rd & 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, alder, maple, cedar, chittem
and crabapple.Dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, sallal, vine maple
and briars, 80.00 chs.

Aug. 12, 1894.

17.50 Top of a ridge, course N. & S. about 450 ft. above cor.

Descend.

39.00 A dry creek bed, 4 lks. wide, course N.20*E.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a stone 12x10x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A chittem, 5 ins. diam., bears N.42*E. 37 lks. dist.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.53.00 Top of a ridge, course N. about 300 ft. above last dry
creek.

Descend.

64.00 Enter creek bottom, course NW. & SE. about 300 ft.

below top of ridge.

67.00 Schofield Creek, 25 lks. wide, course N.60*W.

Ascend.

80.50 Top of a spur, sloping S. about 300 ft. above creek.

Descend.
