Intersect N. & S. line 5.75 chs. S. of cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 & 29 at which point I set a stone 20x12x10 ins. 14 ins. in ground for closing cor. to secs. 20 & 29, marked C. C. with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. edges, from which

A cherry, 6 ins. diam., bears S.75*W. 24 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 29 B T.

A cherry, 7 ins. diam., bears N.48*W. 20 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 20 B T.

A myrtle, 6 ins. diam., bears N.81*E. 20 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W C C S 20 & 29 B T.

Land, 83.60 chs. mountainous.

Soil, 3rd & 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, alder, cherry and chittem.

Dense undergrowth of thimbleberry, cherry, salmonberry, vine maple & briars, 84.60 chs.

West, on a true line bet. secs. 19 & 30.

Var. 19*35'E.

Descend.

1.55 A stream, 5 lks. wide, course NE.

Ascend.

16.00 Top of a ridge, course N. & S. about 375 ft. above last stream.

Descend.

38.05 A dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course NW. about 350 ft. below top of last ridge.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which

A chittem, 12 ins. diam., bears S.12*W. 27 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
