	<p>A vine maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N.72*W. 85 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>
42.30	<p>Top of a ridge, course N. about 100 ft. above last dry creek.</p> <p>Descend.</p>
45.50	<p>A stream, 4 lks. wide, course N.20*E. about 150 ft. below top of last ridge.</p> <p>Ascend.</p>
52.80	<p>Top of a spur on N. slope about 300 ft. above last stream.</p> <p>Descend.</p>
56.10	<p>Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 12.69 chs. N. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on E. bdy. of sec. 25, T. 22 S., R 12 W. at which point I set a stone 14x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to sec. 19 & 30, marked C.
