A dead cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears S.33\*E. 46 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S.57\*W. 58 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

An alder, 4 ins. diam., bears N.19\*W. 28 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 11 W S 30 B T.

Land, 80.00 chs. mountainous.

Soil, 3rd & 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with alder, fir, willow, cedar, and hemlock.
