South, bet. Secs. 19 and 24.

Va. 19°30'E.

9.25 Bank of Lake, course SE and NW.

Set meander post from which

A Spruce, 40 ins. diam., bears N.12°E., 39 lks.  
dist.

A Spruce, 40 ins. diam., bears N.74°W., 21 lks.  
dist.

9.60 Set mark at edge of water.

Regained line across arm of lake.

Ran base N.53°E., 283 lks. dist.

Mark in edge of water bears N.15-3/4°W., hence by  
traverse 9.69 chs. distance across.

19.00 Margin of Lake set meander post, from which

A Red Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 25 lks.  
dist.

A Spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears S.28°E., 16 lks.  
dist.

19.29 Beginning of base.

21.00 Bank of Lake, course N and S.

24.18 Offset E. 100 lks. to avoid point of marsh from  
lake, 4.37 chains.

28.55 Return West to line.

29.71 Set meander post on banks of lake, course E, from which

A Spruce, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 8°E., 27 lks.  
dist.

A Cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears S.86°W., 19 lks.  
dist.

30.25 To pole in water.

On South side pole in water bears N.12°15'W.

Measured base S.85°W., 3.09 chs. thence N.37°W., 1.34  
chs., thence West 1.15 chs. thence N.40°W., 2.46 chs.  
thence North 1.50 chs. to meander corner distance  
over from pole in water 26.23.
