under Contract No. 69, dated February 2, 1857

This Township is made fractional by mountains in the South part, which makes it necessary to depart from the usual form of survey.

South, on true line bet. Secs. 2 and 3.

4.00 Right bank of Schofield River, set post

from which:

A Crab, 4 ins. diam., bears N.2\*W., 100 lks. dist.

A Crab, 4 ins. diam., bears N.2\*E., 94 lks. dist.

Base S.30\*E., 2.90 S.9\*E., 5.30 angle opposite is 16½\* dist., 15.44 chs. over

19.44 Left Bank of River set post from which:

A Hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.16\*W., 36 lks. dist.

A Vinemaple, 24 ins. diam., bears S.5\*W., 6 lks. dist.

34.00 Stream 1 lk. wide course NW.

40.00 Set ¼ Sec. post from which:

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.18\*E., 20 lks. dist.

A Hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S.25\*W., 11 lks. dist.

41.50 Ridge course NE.

55.00 Stream 2 lks. wide, course NE

71.00 Ridge, course E and W.

80.00 Set post cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, from which:

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.21\*W., 17 lks. dist.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.50\*E., 24 lks. dist.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.13\*E., 17 lks. dist.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.64\*W., 26 lks. dist.

North ½ mile hilly. South ½ mile mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.
