CHAINS

A Hemlock, 7 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 8 lks. dist.

An Alder, 12 ins. diam., bears N.17*W., 35 lks. dist.

Land, mountainous, very heavily timbered with Spruce, Hemlock and Fir.

Undergrowth, Whortleberry.

Feb. 7th, 1880.

West, on North boundary Sec. 5.

Va.19½*E.

Descend mountain slope W.

11.75 Intersect lake. Set Hemlock post 5x5 by 4 ft. long for witness post, from which

A Fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S.16*E., 31 lks. dist.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 20 lks. dist.

Caused flag to be placed on opposite side, then run

South 200 chs. to a point from which flag bears

N.75*W giving for distance, 746 lks. at

19.50 Set Hemlock post, 5x5 by 4½ ft. long in ground for witness corner from which

An Alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.27*W., 13 lks. dist.

An Alder, 8 ins. diam., bears S.10*E., 25 lks. dist.

Ascend mountain slope E.

40.00 Set Cedar post 4x4 by 5 ft. long in ground for ¼ Sec. corner, from which

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.43*W., 23 lks. dist.

A Cedar, 24 ins. diam., bears S.76*E., 13 lks. dist.

42.00 Top of mountain, - descend.

68.00 Intersect lake about 15 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ chs. across.

Set Hemlock post, 4x5 by 4½ ft. long in ground, from which

A Spruce, 24 ins. diam., bears S.64*W., 10 lks. dist.

A Cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N.52*W., 12 lks. dist.

Did not continue line any further.
