

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 12 W., W.M.  
 As Surveyed by William Thiel, Deputy Surveyor under  
 Contract No. 534, dated January 18th, 1889.

CHAINS

I began at the cor. to Secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, which is a Maple 8 ins. in diam., now cut down, with only the stump remaining; I replace the same by setting a Fir post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 22 S S 24 on NE R 12 W S 25 on SE S 26 on SW, S 23 on NW faces, with 2 notches on S and 1 notch on E edges, from which

Stump of Alder, 36 ins. diam., bears S.30\*W.,  
 39 lks. dist., marked B T.

Stump of Alder, 36 ins. diam., bears N.89\*W.,  
 70 lks. dist., marked B T.

Stump of Maple, 8 ins. diam., bears N.50\*E.,  
 12 lks. dist., marked B T.

A Spruce, (given as a Fir) 10 ins. diam., bears  
 S.65\*E., 40 lks. dist., marked S 25 T 22 S R 12  
 W B T.

in accordance with the description in the field notes furnished me. In place of the Maple I give as additional bearing tree

A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.2\*E., 1.67 chs.  
 dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 24 B T.

No other trees within limits W of corner. Thence South bet. Secs. 25 and 26.

Va. 20\*10'E.

Slight descent.

- .50 A cleared bottom, bears S.15\*E and N.15\*W.
- 1.40 A creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.20\*W,
- 3.00 Leave bottom, begin ascent of a timbered and brushy spur, bears N and S.
- 18.00 A trail on top of spur, course S.10\*E and N.10\*W. +400
- Begin descent.
- 23.50 A canyon, course West, begin ascent of a westslope of a spur. -60
