Steep ascent of W slope.

8.00	Leave green timber, enter burnt timber, covered with thick undergrowth. Clearing of Fox bears S.70°W.	
10.75	Top of ridge, bears SW and NE, the ocean is visible, begin descent.	+500
28.50	A canyon, course SE, begin ascent.	-700
34.00	A spur bears SE and NW, begin descent.	+50
40.00	A Cherry, 6 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{2}$ S on W face for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. corner, from which A Cherry, 6 ins. diam., bears N.50°E., 8 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T. A Cherry, 4 ins. diam., bears S.39 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 11 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.	-300

42.50	Foot of descent.	-50
43.20	A creek 5 lks. wide, course S.80°W.	
44.50	A trail, course E and W.	
46.50	Begin ascent of N slope of burnt mountain, covered with dense undergrowth.	
71.50	Top of mountain, bears SW and NE, begin descent.	+900
80.46	Intersect North boundary of township 23 South, Range 12 West, 69. ²⁰ ₀₀ chs. East of corner to Secs. 2 and 3, which is a Crabapple post, 6 ins. sq. 24 ins. above ground, marked S 35 T 22 Son NE S 2 R 12 W on SE, S 3 T 23 S on SW S 34 on NW faces with 2 notches on	-200
