A Spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears N.85°E., 44 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 3 B T.

A Cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 28 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 10 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.18½°W., 27 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 9 B T.

A Cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.12°W., 18 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 4 B T.

in accordance with the description given in the field notes furnished me.
