	<p>South, bet. Secs. 28 and 29.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Va. 20*15'E.</p> <p>Descend along W. slope of mountain.</p>	
6.00	A gulch, course W., begin ascent.	- 80
10.50	Top of spur, bears E and W., begin descent.	+120
18.00	A branch, 4 lks. wide, course W., begin ascent.	-120
21.50	Top of spur, bears SW and NE., keep ascending W. slope.	+160
30.50	Top of spur, bears E and W. begin to descend.	+250
40.00	<p>Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N.67*W., 34 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S.81*E., 62 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>	- 80
	Keep descending.	
48.00	A canyon, course W., begin ascent.	-120
53.50	Top of spur, bears E and W., begin descent.	+110
58.00	A canyon, course W., begin ascent.	- 60
68.00	Top of a dividing ridge, bears E and W., descend along W. slope.	+250
80.00	<p>Set a Hemlock post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, marked T 22 S S 28 on NE, R 12 W S 33 on SE, S 32 on SW, S 29 on NW face, with 1 notch on S and 4 notches on E. edges, from which:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Hemlock, 21 ins. diam., bears N.49*E., 20 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 28 B T.</p>	- 60
