CHAINS

setting an Alder post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground, marked M C R 12 W on W., T 23 S S 3 on S., T 22 S S 34 on N. face, from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.89°E., 30 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 34 M C B T.

A Cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S.17½°E., 9 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 12 W S 3 M C B T.

Thence I run with meanders in Sec. 34.

Va.20°15'E.

N.31°E 6.50 chs. steep timbered hill slope.

N.76°W 6.00 chs. cross marsh.

S.25°W 8.00 chs. steep timbered hill slope.

to North boundary of township 23 S., there having been no meander cor. established, I set a Cedar post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for meander cor. to fractional section 34, marked M C on E., T 23 S S 3 on S., T 22 S S 34 on N., R 12 W on W. face, from which

An Alder, 15 ins. diam., bears N.38°E., 29 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 34 M C B T.

A Crabapple, 4 ins. diam., bears S.43½°W., 9 lks. dist., marked T 23 S R 12 W S 3 M C B T.

Meander cor. on East side of Lake bears S.88°49'E., 5.98 chs. dist.

Land on E and W side, mountainous; on N side, level marsh.

Soil, on E and W side, rocky - 3rd rate, on N. side rich loam, - 1st rate.

Timber, Spruce, Fir, Cedar, Alder, Crabapple, Chittewood.

Undergrowth, Salmonberry, Vinemaple.

Meanders of the North end of Black Lake in Sec. 33.

I begin at the meander post to fractional Sec. 33 on

South boundary of township, which is a Hemlock post,

5 ins. sq. 24 ins. above ground, marked W C on W. face,
