

## SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 22 S., R. 12 W.

CHAINS

A Spruce, 40 ins. diam., bears S.65\*W., 15 lks.  
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 30 M C B T.

April 6th, 1891.

26.80 Intersect arm of Lake. Set Willow post, 3x4 ins. sq.  
4 ft. long, 2 ft. in ground for Meander corner to  
fractional sections 19 and 30, marked M C on West,  
T 22 S S 19 on North, R 12 W on E and S 30 on South,  
from which

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.40\*E., 6 lks.  
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 30 M C B T.

A Mountain Balm, 5 ins. diam., bears N.20\*E.,  
8 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 19 M C B T.

I then set flag at Meander corner and go to object on  
line on West side of Lake.

I run South 250 lks. for base flag at meander corner  
on East side bears N.77½\*E., angle opposite 12\*.  
Distance over 11.74 chains.

I find that I am West of the Coast Meridian. I find an  
Alder on North bank of Lake marked on West side T.22  
S R 12 W S 19 B T, from which I run S.80\*W, 40 lks. to  
place of Meander corner on Coast Meridian. No post  
found.

The Alder bearing West 22 lks. has fallen down and all  
marks rotted off.

I now run West 120 lks. from which my object in line  
bears South 105 lks. My intersection is therefore

37.34 Intersect Coast Meridian 20 lks. North of corner to  
Secs.. 19, 30, 24 and 25.

At place of Meander corner 125 lks. North I set a  
Chittim post 4 ins. sq. 5 ft. long, 2½ ft. in ground  
for meander cor. for fractional secs.. 19 and 24,  
marked M C on South, T 22 S on North, R 12 W S 19 on  
East and R 13 W S 24 on West faces, from which
