

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 22 S., R. 12 W.

CHAINS

A Chittim, 10 ins. diam., bears S.85\*W., 50 lks. dist., which I marked T 22. S R 13 W S 24 M C B T. The Alder bearing N.80\*E., 40 lks. dist., still standing. Land, mountainous. Soil, good, 2nd rate. Timber, Fir, Spruce, Hemlock, Alder and Maple. Dense undergrowth of Salmonberry, Salal, Whortleberry and Briars.

April 7th, 1891.

From the corner to Secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, I run South, on true line between Secs. 29 and 30.

Va. 20\*21'E.

Ascend hill slope North.

- 1.25 Top of hill, enter bench. +150
- 1.90 Fir, 36 ins. diam.
- 6.40 Spring on line runs S.60\*W.
- 9.00 Top of flat spur E and W - descend.
- 14.00 Stream, 1 lk. wide, runs W. -25
- 16.00 Spur E and W descend.
- 18.00 Ravine, West - ascend
- 23.00 Spur SW and NE; descend steep hill.
- April 7, 1891.
- 26.00 Stream 5 lks. wide, runs SW. -100
- 26.75 Spurs E and W.
- 27.40 Stream 3 lks. wide, runs NW.
- Ascend steep hill.
- 29.00 Spur E and W; descend.
- 31.30 Stream 3 lks. wide, runs N.60\*W.
- Ascend steep hill.
- 34.00 A Spruce, 40 ins. diam.
- 34.60 Top of spur nearly N and S.
- 37.00 Recross spur NE and SW.
- 40.00 Set Hemlock post, 4 ins. sq. 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in ground, marked 1/2 S on West face for 1/2 Sec. corner, from which
