CHAINS

A Fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.45°E., 39 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 30 M C B T.

Ascend along SW slope.

63.00 Spur nearly E and W.

66.00 Spur N and S.

68.50 Ravine, South.

70.50 Spur N and S.

76.35 Corner to Secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Land, slightly rolling.

Soil, along margin of lake and bottom 1st rate. Remainder good, 2nd rate.

Timber, Fir, Spruce, Cedar, and Hemlock and on West 4.00 chs. Dwarf Pine.

April 9th, 1891.

South, on true line between Secs. 31 and 32.

Va. 20°15'E.

Descend steep hill.

2.10 Stream 3 lks. wide runs SW

Ascend

5.00 Spur E and W Descend.

8.25 Stream 2 lks wide runs West.

Ascend.

10.00 Spurs N and S. Descend.

12.00 Stream 2 lks. wide runs NW.

Ascend steep spur.

17.25 Spruce, 8 ft. in diam.

23.00 Top of spur E and W

Descend.

34.60 Stream 1 lk. wide runs S.60°W, thence along bench at foot of hill East of line.

40.00 Set Hemlock post, 3x5 ins. sq, 4½ ft. long, 2 ft. in ground for ¼ Section cor. marked ¼ S on West face, from which

A Hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.7°W., 30 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.
