8.50 Flat spur N and S.

11.00 Intersect West shore of Lake Edna.

Set a Fir post, 4 ins. sq. 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in ground
for meander corner marked M C on E, T 22 S on W, R 12
W S 30 on S. S 30 on North, from which

A Pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S.6°E., 40 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 30 M C B T.

A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.29°W, 27 lks.
dist., marked T 22 S R 12 W S 30 M C B T.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, poor and sandy.

Timber, Dwarf Pine and Fir.

Undergrowth, Whortleberry and Laurel.

Meanders of T. 22 S. R 12 W.

Begin at the meander corner on West side of Lake 11.00
chs. East of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner on West boundary
of Section 30.
