

## RETRACEMENTS OF EAST BDY. OF T. 22 S. R. 12 W.

CHAINS

Set a sandstone, 20x10x8 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of Secs. 18 and 19, marked C C on E. with 3 grooves on N and S faces, from which

A Hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N.72\*E., 7 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 11 W S 18 B T.

A Hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears S.79\*E., 45 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 11 W S 19 B T.

79.36 Intersect the old cor. of Secs. 13 and 24, already described, 1000 ft. below  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. cor.

Note: On account of errors in the old work I cannot close on this cor. so I reestablish it for angle point as follows:

Set a sandstone, 15x10x8 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for angle cor. marked A P on N E face: from which

A Cherry, 16 ins. diam., bears S.57\*W., 51 lks. dist., marked A P B T.

A Spruce, 8 ins, diam., bears N.4\*W., 25 lks. dist., marked A P B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Chittam and Maple.

Undergrowth, Vinemaple, Alder, Huckleberry & Salmonberry and Fern.

From the angle cor. of Secs. 13 and 24 on the E. bdy. of the township, I run

North, on a true line, on E. bdy. of Sec. 13.

Abrupt descent on N. slope thru heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.99 Schofield River, 35 lks. wide, 24 ins. deep, course S.70\*W., 150 ft. below angle corner.

Over bottom land in clearing.

3.64 Wagon road, bears E and W.

Charles Walker's house and improvements bears S.66\*E., about 20.00 chs. dist.

6.83 Leave bottom, bears E and W., and ascend steep S. slope through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
